



### December 17, 2024: Online meeting "Migration and Health"

ON THE OCCASION OF INTERNATIONAL MIGRANTS' DAY, THE REGIONAL EXPERT GROUP INVITED ANNA ARIABINSKAYA TO PARTICIPATE IN AN ONLINE MEETING DEDICATED TO THE TOPIC OF PROVIDING HEALTH CARE TO PEOPLE IN MIGRATION: "MIGRATION AND HEALTH. COORDINATION OF EFFORTS OF ORGANIZATIONS PROVIDING ASSISTANCE AND FORMATION OF MIGRANT COMMUNITIES IN THE VECA REGION". THE MEETING PRESENTED THE EXPERIENCE OF ORGANIZATIONS PROVIDING ASSISTANCE TO REFUGEES AND MIGRANTS IN THE ISSUES OF HIV AND OTHER DISEASES.

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PEOPLE OFTEN CHANGE THEIR COUNTRY OF RESIDENCE DURING MIGRATION DUE TO CIRCUMSTANCES AND AS A RESULT MAY LOSE ACCESS TO THERAPY AND TREATMENT OF HIV AND OTHER DISEASES. ONE OF THE CHALLENGES IS TO MAINTAIN ACCESS TO TREATMENT FOR CLIENTS THROUGHOUT THE MIGRATION PROCESS. THE MEETING DISCUSSED SOLUTIONS TO MAINTAIN THE SUSTAINABILITY OF SERVICES NEEDED BY REFUGEES AND MIGRANTS IN THE VIECA REGION, AND PRESENTED AN ANALYSIS OF THE DEVELOPMENT OF MIGRANT COMMUNITIES IN EUROPE.

ALL OF THIS WITH ONE GOAL IN MIND - TO SUPPORT PEOPLE LIVING WITH HIV AND BREAK DOWN STEREOTYPES ABOUT LIVING WITH THE VIRUS. INTERNAL AND EXTERNAL STIGMATIZATION IS AN ACUTE ISSUE IN MODERN SOCIETY. HIV IS NOT A SENTENCE OR A "PUNISHMENT FOR BAD DEEDS".

EVERY PERSON WHO HAS HAD UNPROTECTED SEX AT LEAST ONCE IN THEIR LIFE IS AT RISK, WHICH IS THE ENTIRE ADULT POPULATION OF OUR PLANET. NOWADAYS, THERE IS A CURE AND COMPLETE CONTROL OVER THIS CHRONIC DISEASE.

OFFSPRING.

THE MOST IMPORTANT ELEMENT IS TIMELY TESTING, DIAGNOSIS AND TREATMENT. WITH JUST ONE PILL A DAY, EVERY PERSON LIVING WITH HIV CAN CONTINUE TO LIVE A FULL, QUALITY AND HAPPY LIFE. THEY CAN CONTINUE TO BUILD HEALTHY RELATIONSHIPS WITHOUT PASSING THE VIRUS ON TO THEIR PARTNERS AND THEIR FUTURE

THE WORST THING IS NOT KNOWING ABOUT YOUR STATUS. FEAR, PREJUDICE AND STEREOTYPES, AND MOST IMPORTANTLY, THE LACK OF POSITIVE.

OPEN INFORMATION ABOUT HIV IN THE MEDIA SPACE, DEPRIVE MANY PEOPLE OF THE OPPORTUNITY TO LIVE A LONG AND HAPPY LIFE. IGNORANCE BREEDS FEAR AND REJECTION. PEOPLE WITH HIV OFTEN EXPERIENCE GREAT PSYCHOLOGICAL PRESSURE AND ARE VULNERABLE TO VARIOUS TYPES OF

VIOLENCE. TO MAKE THE SITUATION MORE FAVORABLE, IT IS NECESSARY TO TELL AS MUCH AS POSSIBLE, TO INFORM AND TO BREAK OUTDATED STEREOTYPES. AND IT IS BEST IF THIS IS DONE ON A DAILY BASIS BY REPRESENTATIVES OF THE COMMUNITY OF PEOPLE LIVING WITH HIV, NOT ONLY INFECTIOUS DISEASE DOCTORS AND PUBLIC ORGANIZATIONS. SUCH OPENNESS AND PERSONAL EXAMPLE CAN HELP OVERCOME STIGMA.

ANNA ARIABINSKA HAS BEEN DOING THIS FOR MANY YEARS - FIRST IN UKRAINE.

AND NOW IN POLAND. "WHEN I WAS OFFERED TO PARTICIPATE IN THIS PROJECT," SAYS ANNA, "I AGREED WITH GREAT JOY. AFTER ALL, IF AN OPEN CONVERSATION, MY

PERSONAL STORY, HELPS OTHERS FEEL BETTER AND MORE CONFIDENT, INSPIRES THEM TO GET TESTED AND TREATED, THEN I AM ON THE RIGHT WAY! MY KNOWLEDGE AND EXPERIENCE ALLOW ME TO PROVIDE QUALITY SUPPORT AND COUNSELING TO PEOPLE LIVING WITH HIV IN ANY COUNTRY."

## HIV TESTING PROGRAM (CONTINUATION OF INTERNATIONAL COOPERATION

HEALTH IS THE MOST VALUABLE RESOURCE WE HAVE. THAT'S WHY IT'S IMPORTANT TO TAKE CARE OF YOURSELF AND YOUR WELL-BEING ON A REGULAR BASIS. FUNDACJA HELPNOWHUB PROVIDES A UNIQUE OPPORTUNITY TO GET TESTED FOR HIV, HEPATITIS B AND C, AND SYPHILIS FREE OF CHARGE AND ANONYMOUSLY.

#### WHY IS IT IMPORTANT?

MANY DISEASES, SUCH AS HIV, HEPATITIS OR #SYPHILIS, CAN GO ON WITHOUT SYMPTOMS FOR A LONG TIME.TIMELY DETECTION OF THESE DISEASES ALLOWS YOU TO START TREATMENT, AVOID SERIOUS COMPLICATIONS AND PROTECT YOUR CLOSE ONES.

EARLY DIAGNOSIS OF INFECTIOUS DISEASES IS THE KEY TO SUCCESSFUL TREATMENT AND PREVENTION OF THEIR SPREAD. FOR EXAMPLE, MODERN ANTIRETROVIRAL THERAPY ALLOWS PEOPLE WITH #HIV TO LIVE LONG AND FULFILLING LIVES IF DIAGNOSED ON TIME. #HEPATITIS C, WHICH WAS ONCE CONSIDERED INCURABLE, IS NOW FULLY CURABLE THANKS TO MODERN MEDICATIONS.

IN ADDITION, KNOWING YOUR STATUS HELPS TO PREVENT THE SPREAD OF THE DISEASE TO OTHER PEOPLE. THIS IS NOT ONLY A STEP TOWARDS YOUR OWN HEALTH, BUT ALSO A RESPONSIBILITY TO SOCIETY.

ANONYMOUS TESTING IS SIMPLE AND SAFE. IT GIVES YOU THE OPPORTUNITY TO CHECK YOUR HEALTH STATUS WITHOUT FEAR OF JUDGMENT OR DISCRIMINATION. THE PROCEDURE IS SIMPLE AND COMPLETELY CONFIDENTIAL.

TESTING IS CONDUCTED USING MODERN METHODS THAT GUARANTEE ACCURACY AND SPEED OF RESULTS. ALL MATERIALS USED DURING THE TESTING ARE DISPOSABLE AND STERILE, WHICH ELIMINATES ANY RISK OF INFECTION.

AFTER TESTING, EVERYONE CAN GET EXPERT ADVICE AND, IF NECESSARY, ASSISTANCE IN FURTHER TREATMENT.



### Main objectives of the projecty

IMPROVING ACCESS TO MEDICAL CARE:
PROVIDING UKRAINIAN REFUGEES AND VULNERABLE GROUPS
WITH BASIC MEDICAL SERVICES, INCLUDING ANTIRETROVIRAL
THERAPY (ART), SUBSTITUTION THERAPY (ST), HEPATITIS AND
TUBERCULOSIS TREATMENT.

OVERCOMING BARRIERS SUCH AS STIGMA, REMOTENESS OF HEALTH CENTERS AND OVERLOADED HEALTH CARE SYSTEM.

PSYCHOSOCIAL AND LEGAL SUPPORT: COUNSELING ON MEDICAL CARE, REFUGEE RIGHTS, AND SOCIAL INTEGRATION.

ASSISTANCE IN OVERCOMING DISCRIMINATION, STIGMA AND PSYCHOLOGICAL PROBLEMS.

SELF-HELP GROUPS, POLISH LANGUAGE CLASSES, AND CULTURAL EVENTS (CONCERTS, MEETINGS) ARE ORGANIZED.

ASSISTANCE IN DIFFICULT CASES, E.G:
RELOCATION OF PATIENTS TO OTHER CITIES/COUNTRIES (E.G., NORWAY) WITHOUT INTERRUPTING TREATMENT.


#### **ACHIEVEMENTS**

ALL PROJECT GOALS WERE ACHIEVED ON TIME.
INCREASED CONFIDENCE AMONG REFUGEES - 185 SESSIONS OF
PSYCHOLOGICAL ASSISTANCE WERE CONDUCTED.
DIALOGUE WITH POLISH GOVERNMENT AGENCIES TO IMPROVE
CONDITIONS FOR REFUGEES WAS ESTABLISHED.

#### IMPACT ON THE COMMUNITY

REFUGEES RECEIVED NOT ONLY EMERGENCY ASSISTANCE, BUT ALSO TOOLS FOR LONG-TERM INTEGRATION.
A SUPPORT NETWORK HAS BEEN CREATED THAT ALLOWS PEOPLE TO HELP EACH OTHER.

# From barriers to solutions: a qualitative study of access to HIV and TB treatment for forced migrants from Ukraine

OUR FOUNDATION'S EXPERTS TOOK AN ACTIVE PART IN THIS STUDY.

WORKING WITH THE COMMUNITY, WE MANAGED TO PROVIDE HIGHQUALITY DATA AND PERSONAL STORIES, WHICH ALLOWED US TO IDENTIFY

REAL BARRIERS AND WAYS TO OVERCOME THEM. OUR EXPERIENCE
WORKING WITH VULNERABLE GROUPS HELPED US GAIN AN IN-DEPTH
UNDERSTANDING OF THE NEEDS OF DISPLACED PERSONS AND INFLUENCE
THE DEVELOPMENT OF EFFECTIVE SOLUTIONS.

THIS STUDY EXAMINES THE BARRIERS FACED BY PEOPLE WHO FLED UKRAINE AFTER THE RUSSIAN INVASION IN ACCESSING TREATMENT FOR HIV, TUBERCULOSIS (TB) AND OPIOID AGONIST THERAPY (OAT). THE STUDY AIMS TO UNDERSTAND HOW FORCED MIGRATION INTERSECTS WITH ACCESS TO HEALTH CARE IN WARTIME, DRAWING ON CONCEPTS OF SOCIAL DETERMINANTS OF HEALTH AND TRANSNATIONALISM.

#### **METHODOLOGY**

THE RESEARCH IS BASED ON IN-DEPTH INTERVIEWS CONDUCTED IN 2023-2025 AS PART OF AN INTERNATIONAL PUBLIC PROJECT COVERING SIX COUNTRIES. THE EMPIRICAL DATA WERE ANALYZED TO IDENTIFY SYSTEMIC, REGULATORY, AND LANGUAGE BARRIERS, WITH A PARTICULAR FOCUS ON HOW THESE FACTORS AFFECT TREATMENT DECISIONS AMONG FORCIBLY DISPLACED PERSONS.

#### RESULTS

THE RESULTS SHOW THAT BOTH THE HEALTH SYSTEMS OF THE HOST COUNTRIES AND UKRAINE HAVE BEEN INVOLVED IN DEVELOPING RESPONSES TO THE CHALLENGES OF MIGRATION. REFUGEES FACE SERIOUS

#### BARRIERS

DURING THEIR MOVEMENT, SUCH AS A LACK OF INTERPRETERS, INTERRUPTIONS IN TREATMENT, AND COMPLEX BUREAUCRATIC PROCEDURES. COMMUNITY INITIATIVES HAVE PLAYED A KEY ROLE IN OVERCOMING THESE BARRIERS BY PROVIDING ACCESS TO TREATMENT THROUGH ADVOCACY, PEER SUPPORT, AND INFORMAL ASSISTANCE IN NAVIGATING THE SYSTEM. USING THE CONCEPT

OF CROSS-BORDER PATIENT MOBILITY, THE STUDY SHOWS HOW PEOPLE WITH MULTIPLE VULNERABILITIES OVERCOME THE TRAUMA OF WAR, DISPLACEMENT, FAMILY SEPARATION AND SOCIAL ISOLATION.

#### CONCLUSIONS

THE STUDY EMPHASIZES THE NEED TO DEVELOP HEALTH SERVICES ADAPTED TO THE NEEDS OF MIGRANTS AND TO SUPPORT COMMUNITY-BASED INITIATIVES. TO PROVIDE HEALTH CARE FOR DISPLACED PERSONS, IT IS NECESSARY TO RECOGNIZE AND INVEST IN COMMUNITY-BASED SOLUTIONS, ESPECIALLY IN TIMES OF ONGOING CRISES AND INSTABILITY.

HOW TO IDENTIFY THEIR OWN BOUNDARIES AND RESPOND TO THEIR
VIOLATION IN TIME TO STOP

THE GROWING AGGRESSION OF THE ATTACKER AND REDUCE THE

LIKELIHOOD OF PHYSICAL ATTACK.



### PERFORMANCE BY THE "GRUND" THEATER IN BYDGOSZCZ

THE FORMAT IS ALWAYS UNIQUE - NO REPETITION IS POSSIBLE. THE AUDIENCE BECOMES ACTIVE PARTICIPANTS AND ACTORS IN THE CREATIVE PROCESS.

THE ACTORS TELL A SPECIFIC STORY THAT WAS HEARD FROM THE AUDIENCE THROUGH IMPROVISATION, PLASTICITY, POETRY, DANCE AND MUSIC. THEY SHARE THEIR OWN REAL STORIES AND EXPERIENCES WITH

THE AUDIENCE. SOMEONE WAS WORRIED ABOUT THEIR RELATIVES WHO REMAINED IN UKRAINE.

SOMEONE SHARED A JOYFUL EVENT IN THE FAMILY AND THEIR REGRET THAT THEY COULD NOT BE THERE BECAUSE OF THE WAR. PAIN, REGRET, FEAR, JOY AND PRIDE FOR THE CHILDREN

ALL BECAME ELEMENTS OF THE THEATER. THE RESULT WAS A UNIQUE AND VERY COHERENT STORY ABOUT PEOPLE, ABOUT WHAT IS TRULY DEAR TO THEM AND LIVES IN THEIR HEARTS. BEFORE THE FINALE, ALL THE AUDIENCE WAS INVITED TO LOOK AROUND AND SHAKE HANDS WITH A NEIGHBOR, TALK TO THEM, GET TO KNOW THEM. AS A RESULT, MANY VIEWERS MADE NEW

FRIENDS, WITH DIFFERENT LIFE EXPERIENCES, OR VICE VERSA, VERY SIMILAR,
DESPITE THE

SEEMING DIFFERENCES.

THANKS TO THE ACTORS OF THE "GRUND" THEATER, PEOPLE WERE ABLE TO GET EMOTIONAL SUPPORT AND UNDERSTANDING OF OTHERS, AND MAYBE THEMSELVES.





















